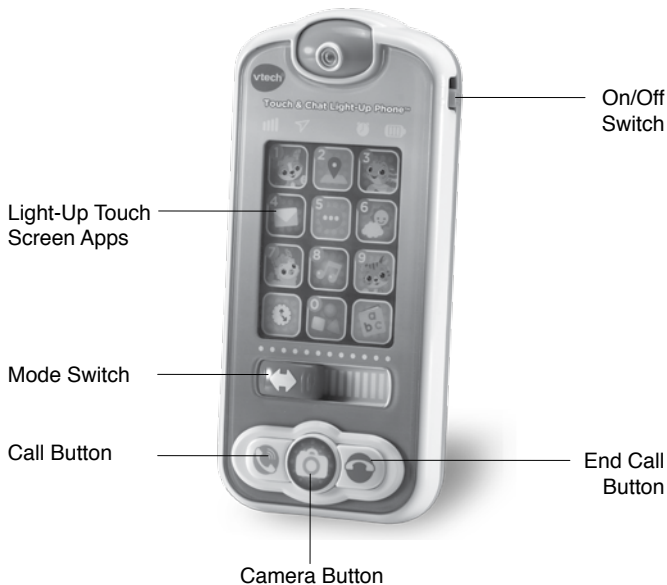

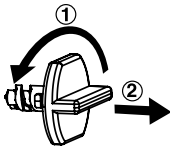

## Unlock the Packaging Lock

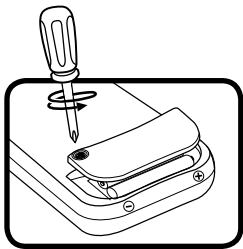


- ① Rotate the packaging lock counterclockwise several times.
- ② Pull out the packaging lock and discard.

# GETTING STARTED

## Battery Removal and Installation

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



### WARNING / ATTENTION:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

## IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.

- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

### **RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES**

- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

- Enlever les piles ou les accumulateurs usagés du jouet.
- Ne les jeter ni au feu ni dans la nature.

### **PILES RECHARGEABLES**

- Enlever, lorsque c'est possible, les accumulateurs du jouet pour

les recharger.

- Les accumulateurs ne doivent être chargés que sous la surveillance d'un adulte.
- Ne pas tenter de recharger des piles non rechargeables.

## PRODUCT FEATURES

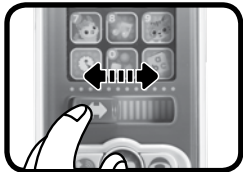
### 1. On/Off Button

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **On** ☺ position. You will hear a sing-along song and a phrase. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **Off** ● position.



### 2. Mode Switch

Switch between Learning mode and Video Call mode by sliding the **Mode Switch** left or right.



### NOTE

Ensure that the screen is not positioned between the two modes. Position the slider completely to the left or the right to guarantee the best use of the toy and for optimal play.

### 3. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Touch & Chat Light-Up Phone™** will automatically shut off after approximately 40 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by sliding the mode switch or by pressing any of the three buttons below the touch screen.

#### NOTE

This product is in Try Me mode in the packaging. After opening the package, make sure the try-me tag is removed from the back of the product, and then turn the unit off and on again to proceed with normal play. If the unit powers down or the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

## ACTIVITIES



### Learning Mode

#### 1. Learning Apps

Press the 12 **Apps** to learn about numbers, shapes and more. These icons also act as phone keys to dial numbers. Slide your finger from app to app to create cool light patterns with playful sounds.



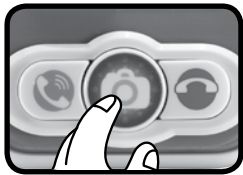
#### 2. Call and End Call Buttons

Press the **Call**  and **End Call**  **Buttons** to imitate using the phone for calls.



### 3. Camera Button

Press the **Camera Button** to hear fun sounds and phrases.



## Video Call Mode

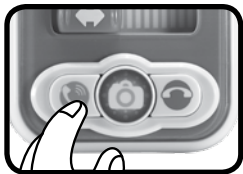
### 1. Animal Friends

Slide the mode switch to Video Call mode and press the lion or elephant to pretend to make a video call and hear their greeting, or press an emotion icon for fun sounds. Slide your finger across the touch screen continuously to hear playful sounds as the lights follow your fingers.



### 2. Call and End Call Buttons

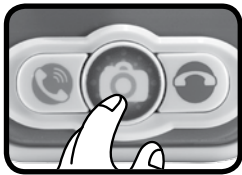
Press the **Call**  and **End Call**  Buttons to imitate a video call.

## **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install with a new set of batteries.
